Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and conform to the general playing rules with the following additions.
2. The tournament is open to all members of the BTBA. Anyone unable to produce a current BTBA membership card may compete on payment of £25.00 fine.
3. All competitors must register 30 minutes prior to roll off which will commence at 9.30am at each venue.
4. The tournament manager will be Peter Churcher and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.
5. A provisional ball shall be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
6. All protests must be lodged with the tournament manager within 30 minutes of the game in which the infringement took place, and subsequently confirmed within 72 hours.
7. No bowler will be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol once practice has begun.
8. Any player whose conduct is considered liable to bring the game into disrepute will be disqualified from the tournament.
9. The wearing of denim jeans, T-shirts and vests is prohibited for all bowlers.
10. All score sheets must be maintained and signed by an opponent from the same pair of lanes. Failure to do so may result in loss of ranking points and/or disqualification from the tournament.
11. All bowling balls must conform to BTBA specifications for weight, balance and hardness. The use of abrasives is prohibited once practice has concluded.

Qualifying Rounds

Senior qualifying round will be on 5th/6th June 2010 – venue to be decided.

Adult qualifying round will be on 4th/5th September 2010 – venue to be decided.

Eligibility Rules

1. Each bowler must be eligible to hold a British Passport or have resided in the UK for at least 5 years.
2. Each bowler must have been born or resided for one year within the boundaries of the county they are representing.
3. Seniors must be aged 50 or over as at 1 May 2010.

Tournament Format

The tournament shall consist of six games at each of the three venues, moving lanes after every two games.

County Ranking Points will be awarded dependant on finishing position, determined by pinfall, at each venue as follows:

1 st	120	3 rd	100	5 th	90	7 th	80	9 th	78
2 nd	110	4 th	95	6 th	85	8 th	79	10 th	77 etc

Overall positions will be determined on total points from each bowler's highest two ranking points from three venues.

The top four ladies and top four men will qualify to represent Sussex with two additional bowlers selected by the team manager, with the exception of the senior ladies team which will be the top three with two additional bowlers selected by the team manager.

The top two ladies and top two men will be guaranteed two games at the qualifying round.

Should there be a tie for first and/or second place, final positions will be decided on each players' pinfall from their two highest ranked events.

Entry Fee

There will be a one off registration fee of £12.50 per person, to include Team England Contribution plus lineage of £22.50 for the first event

Thereafter, the entry fee will be £22.50 per event.

Bowlers wishing to participate in more than one age category may do so on payment of the £5.00 registration fee.
