

The six bowlers with the highest averages from any two venues, (twelve games), will form the squad to compete in the Under 18 County Finals to be held on 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> July, in Nottingham.

**NB the actual squad is subject to final ratification by the SUSSEX COUNTY JUNIOR MANAGEMENT TEAM. Top 2 will bowl at least 2 games**

6. The venues, dates and start times for each roll off are as follows;

7. No bowler shall be permitted to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification. Profane language, improper gestures or abuse of bowling equipment or machinery will also result in disqualification. Any disqualification may result in the loss of scores or awards and any individual so disqualified will be reported to the BTBA for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.

8. Competitors are to wear correct bowling attire during each event. Shirts should show their name or YBC. Casual shorts, denim clothing and jeans of any description are not permitted. The wearing of any hat is at the discretion of the tournament manager. Mobile phones are to be turned to silent and not used in the bowling area during play.

9. **The Tournament Manager's decision upon all matters will be final subject to an individual's right of appeal to the BTBA. Any protest must be made verbally at the time of the occurrence to a County Official and must be confirmed in writing within 72 hours.**

10. No adults or non-bowlers are permitted in the bowling area during play except tournament officials and licensed instructors/coaches who should also be correctly dressed and displaying BTBA licences at all times. The YBC Official's licence does not entitle the holder to instruct or coach..

11. The entry fee for each venue will be **£20** per bowler. There is also a one off registration fee of **£8** payable at the bowler's first trial which includes a 50p contribution to the NAYBC International fund.

### ***The General Playing Rules of the B.T.B.A. will govern the Sussex County Trials together with the following Rules and Conditions***

1. The tournament is open to all Junior members of the BTBA who were born within the boundaries of Sussex, or have resided in the County for the last twelve months. Each participant must be eligible to hold a British Passport or have lived continuously in the UK for the last 5 year
2. Bowlers for the U18 trials must be under the age of 18 as at 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009.
3. If any participant has bowled for another County they must apply for deregistration with the County Secretary at BTBA Head Office and have been deregistered for one year before they can be considered for the **Sussex County Team**. If an individual fails to notify the County Secretary they will become eligible to bowl for Sussex after a period of one year provided they have not been registered to bowl with another County during that time and have resided within Sussex for a minimum of 12 months
4. All bowlers will be required to produce a current BTBA membership card at registration. If they cannot do this, then a fine of £25 shall be paid. Registration will be 30 minutes prior to the advertised starting time for each trial. Latecomers will begin play from the frame in progress on the allocated lane and no score will be given for frames that have been missed.
5. All bowlers must complete a minimum of two trials, (twelve games), to qualify for a place in the final team. Six games will be bowled at each venue, the bowlers moving one pair of lanes after the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> games.
